STATEMENT:

Vancouver Island University recognizes its legal obligations to regulate alcohol consumption on University premises on campus and at other locations at various times and at various events. Accordingly, Vancouver Island University will maintain a Policy and Procedures reflecting that obligation

The Policy and Procedures will apply to all premises owned, leased, or rented by Vancouver Island University, and will apply to all events where alcohol is consumed.

Vancouver Island University requires that alcohol consumed at events held on the premises is done so responsibly, adhering to the laws of the Province, and to this Policy and the Procedures.

In any inconsistency between the procedures under this policy and the applicable laws of the Province of British Columbia (e.g., Liquor Laws), the laws of the Province prevail. Penalties that flow from the violation of this policy and procedures are in addition to those assessed under the Liquor Laws. Penalties are at the discretion of the President or Vice-President and may include withholding permits to hold future events involving consumption of liquor.
